

**NORTH SHORE BRIDGE CLUB
APPEAL AGAINST RULING BY A DIRECTOR**

An appeal against a ruling by a Director **must** be made by informing the director in the following format within 30 minutes of the conclusion of the session in which the ruling was made. The Director must ensure that the opponents are informed of the appeal. The side appealing must then complete Section 1 of the form. The opponents may then complete section 2, but this is not compulsory. This form must then be handed to the Director, who must then complete Section 3. One member of a pair, (or an appointed representative for a team), must sign for their section when it is complete, and the Director must sign for Section 3.

An Appeals Committee consisting of a panel of three, being a Chairman and two others selected by a member the Tournament Committee or the Club General Committee will then hear the appeal as soon as possible. The result of the appeal will appear in Section 4, and a copy of the appeal will be given to each side, with the original entered in the appropriate file of the Club's filing system.
