
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

How do our Lessons and our playing sessions relate?



Beginners

New players start with the 6-week "Introduction to Bridge" that is designed to teach participants the mechanics of playing Bridge, as well as giving them an understanding of basic bidding and play. The 10-week "Bridge Basics" follows, expanding on the basic concepts taught in the first 6 weeks, and introducing some new ideas.

With this beginner program complete, ideally players now spend some time playing Supervised Bridge and consolidating what they have learnt so far. When they are ready, their next set of lessons is "Build on the Basics". This is an ideal course for Bridge players who are returning to the game after a long break. By the end of "Build on the Basics", most players have moved up to playing in the Rookie game.

Improvers

For Improvers we offer Develop Your Skills and Gentle Hand Analysis, aimed at players who have completed "Build on the Basics", and / or been playing Bridge for at least a year. Bidding, defence and declarer play are all targeted, and Hand Analysis is used to consolidate these skills. These players will be thinking about moving up from Rookie to Restricted play.

Intermediate

The "Broaden Your Skills" program advances the concepts and ideas learnt at the Improver level, and participants will typically be aspiring to playing in the Open game.

Director Teaching

Talks are given by the directors before some of the sessions, see below.

Beginners: "Introduction to Bridge (Intro)" and "Bridge Basics (BB)"

The next "Introduction to Bridge" courses will be scheduled for the New Year.

There are two "**Bridge Basics**" courses underway at the moment. face-to-face at East Lindfield, and online. First, the face-to-face version:
